Who are the Children of Mary?

The Children of Mary is a new order of sisters dedicated to spreading devotion to our Lord's Presence in the Most Sacred Eucharist. Their charism, or mission, is to satiate the Thirst of Jesus to be loved in the Most Blessed Sacrament which He expressed immediately before He gave up His life for the whole world in the words "I thirst" (see John 19:28). They also give talks in schools and offer retreats, their houses in Columbus work with the poor and elderly.

The Community currently has 12 sisters. The Motherhouse is located in Cincinnati, Ohio at the Holy Spirit Center. There the sisters spend the day adoring the Lord in the Eucharist, interceding for the Church, and in a particular way for an increase in vocations to the priesthood.

What are the Children of Mary doing?

The sisters have graciously agreed to be a part of our Forty Hours devotion this year. They will be leading a holy hour specifically to pray for vocations and to offer their love to Jesus in the Eucharist. This will be October 1st from 2:30 until 4PM. They will also be coming to the Youth Group meeting later that night beginning at 7:30PM. They are excited to pray for vocations with us as well as meet the young women of this parish.
